Title	Identification of Items of Nursing Care for Fall Prevention for Elderly People with Dementia

Abstract	<p>The aim of this study was to identify nursing care items for falls prevention in older people with dementia in hospitals, from systematic observation to response and assessment, and to obtain suggestions for improving falls prevention care in clinical practice. The research design was a quantitative descriptive study using the Delphi method. A questionnaire survey was administered twice by post to 281 out of 960 gerontological nurses and certified dementia nurses nationwide. Consensus criteria for each item were set as a mean of 4.0 or more for implementation and 80% or more for the proportion of those who judged the item to be important, with reference to previous studies. 121 out of 129 items were agreed upon. The fall prevention care items for older people with dementia included: assessing and arranging living conditions, assessing and arranging risks due to mobility, assessing and caring for the degree of cognitive function, assessing and alleviating primary illness and frailty, assessing and arranging the hospital environment from the patient's perspective, sharing patient information and providing care as a team, and 'Protecting the patient's dignity'. Items related to sensor mats and physical restraints were excluded from compliance. The fall prevention care items for older people with dementia identified in this study are not limited to assessing the cognitive function and mobility of older people with dementia, but also focus on their intentions and living conditions, which can lead to nursing practice that maintains the dignity of older people with dementia and allows them to be hospitalised and cared for with peace of mind. We believe that this will lead to nursing practice that maintains the dignity of older people with dementia and allows them to be hospitalised with peace of mind.</p>
