Abstract	<p>This study aimed to clarify the actual status of mid-level male nurses through the investigation of their career awareness by semi-structured interviews.</p> <p>The study included 7 subjects mostly in their 30s, with about 10 years of experience as a male nurse, and 6 subjects were married with a child/children. They started to think about their career because of the suggestion of their superiors, pursuit of their expertise, and presence of their family. Support from their families and surrounding people included household chores, time adjustments, and mental support, and support from the workplace included understanding of superiors and staff members. Advantages of male nurses included physical strength and care for male patients, while their difficulties included care for female patients and relationship with female staff members.</p> <p>Mid-level male nurses seem to be thinking their work career in the future while keeping a good balance between family life and work by receiving support from their family and advice from surrounding people. Necessary support should be provided to enhance their expertise in the environment where they can take advantage of their strength as male nurses while finding rewarding in the profession of daily nursing care for patients.</p>
