Title	The psychotherapy process with a male junior high student unaware of his father's death.

Abstract	The psychotherapy process for a 14-year-old high school student experiencing abdominal pain who came to a psychotherapist is described. The student had been told almost nothing about his deceased father and was forbidden to talk about him. He described experiencing abdominal pain in the presence of authority figures and in "uninformed" situations such as classroom activities. During the psychotherapy process, the student gradually became more assertive with the therapist and school personnel, even going so far as to talk about his father, a forbidden topic. In parallel, his abdominal pain subsided. This process suggested that the student was affected by a father complex, in a family constellation that he was unable to mention. In his psychotherapy process, MS (Mutual Scribble) and MSSM (Mutual Scribble Story Making) were used. Occasionally, the therapist experienced the same symptoms of abdominal pain as him. It appeared that the student's theme and the therapist's theme resonated, and that the student and therapist empathized with each other at the physical level.
