Title	Factors Influencing Information Gathering by Public Health Nurses During Maternal and Child Health Handbook Issuance for Child Abuse Prevention

Abstract	<p>The purpose of this study is to identify factors influencing public health nurses' information gathering during the issuance of maternal and child health handbooks for child abuse prevention, and to derive implications for effective child abuse prevention measures.</p> <p>A survey was conducted targeting all public health nurses responsible for maternal and child health services in municipalities within Prefecture A. Analysis of six factors potentially influencing the extent of information gathering and the extent of gathering information on 20 items related to child abuse revealed a significant difference in “experience with child abuse cases.” It was found that those with experience supporting child abuse cases were more actively gathering information regarding abuse of older children. No significant differences were found for the other five factors. This suggests that experiencing support for child abuse cases within the first one to two years after assuming maternal and child health duties may enhance the quality of information gathering during the issuance of maternal and child health handbooks, potentially leading to more effective child abuse prevention measures.</p>
