Abstract	[Purpose] This study sought to collate narratives of individuals who were evacuated from their home prefectures with a focus on stress, thereby examining modalities of mental health care for disaster victim support. These individuals were part of the disaster victims support groups that the author has been continuously implementing for after the Great East Japan Earthquake. [Methods] The study examined narratives of participants obtained through activities (52 in total) conducted in the past year since the establishment of the group, classifying and categorizing content related to stress associated with the Great East Japan Earthquake and with evacuation outside the prefecture. [Discussion] This result suggests the importance of understanding the stress of victims and ensuring their safety and security in group support for evacuees outside the prefecture.
