Title	Development of Teaching Materials for Nutrition and Dietary Support in Times of Disaster in a Registered Dietitian Training Course and Study of Their Potential Use

Abstract	In times of disaster, dietitians need skills to take charge of the nutrition and dietary needs of disaster victims, but it is difficult to learn through experience in a dietitian training program. In this study, we developed card-based active learning materials to help students learn how to make decisions and respond to problems and how to solve them in disaster nutrition and dietetic support. Nine cases were selected from the “Collection of Teaching Materials for Exercises Applying the Case Method” to be analyzed, and the cases that were difficult to judge or deal with were extracted and consolidated into 38 questions. Two options for each question were created and used as teaching materials for a card game. After the game, a reflection sheet was created to discuss the events and countermeasures. 24 fourth-year students participated in the exercise using the card game material, and as a result, they said, “I learned that there are problems with the food provided at evacuation centers,” “I learned about various countermeasures,” and so on. The results of the exercise suggested the possibility of learning about nutritional issues and countermeasures in the event of a disaster.
