Title	Inspection study on the relationship between life disorders in WHODAS 2.0 12-item version and DASC-21
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Abstract	<p>The purpose of this study was to investigate the relationship between WHO disability Assessment Schedule : WHODAS 2.0 and The Dementia Assessment Sheet for Community-based Integrated Care System-21 items: DASC-21 and to clarify the relationship between WHODAS 2.0 and cognitive function and life disorders. The degree of cognitive function and life impairment was evaluated by WHODAS 2.0 and DASC-21, and the relationship between the two tests was examined from four points.</p> <p>As a result, a positive correlation ($r = 0.62$, $p < 0.01$) was observed, and the worse the health condition, the lower the cognitive function. Furthermore, when WHODAS 2.0 in the cognitive function retention group and the cognitive function decline group were compared, a significant decrease ($p < 0.01$) was observed in the cognitive function decline group in the total score.</p> <p>In addition, comparing the WHODAS 2.0 of day service users and their families, they found that they tended to evaluate that they could do it more than their families, and the greater the decline in cognitive function, the greater the difference in total scores ($r = 0.70$, $p < 0.01$).</p> <p>On the other hand, we listened to the problems during shopping in daily life and compared WHODAS 2.0 and DASC-21 depending on the presence or absence of problems, but there was no significant difference. It became clear that the shopping itself could be carried out, although there were some problems.</p> <p>From the above results, it was suggested that WHODAS 2.0 may be able to predict the decline in cognitive function, which is an obstacle in daily life.</p>
