Current status of information disclosure on hepatitis B virus vaccination on the homepage of nursing university

We surveyed 269 schools that were confirmed to have published information on their nursing departments in their university websites on the Internet, regarding (1) whether or not they conduct HBV antibody tests and who pays for them, (2) whether or not they provide hepatitis B vaccination and who pays for it, and (3) where the information is published on their websites. The HBV antibody test was confirmed to have been conducted in 81 cases (30.1%) and not stated in 188 cases (69.9%). The university paid for 3 cases (1.1%), 11 cases (4.1%) were paid by students, 1 case (0.4%) was recommended by each university, and 254 cases (94.4%) were not indicated. Hepatitis B vaccination was confirmed in 57 (21.2%) of the cases, 1 (0.4%) was recommended by each student, and 211 (78.4%) was not stated. The cost-sharers were universities in 9 cases (3.3%), students in 40 cases (14.9%), and 220 cases (81.8%) with no mention of cost-sharers. 3. In addition to "infection prevention measures" and "health management," information on hepatitis B vaccination is posted in "school fees" and "information on costs after enrollment" on each university's website.
