Abstract	<p>The purpose of this research activity is to archive the life histories (oral histories) of A-bomb survivors by interviewing and researching them together with the younger generation (university students).</p> <p>Through this work, we will learn about the tragedy of war, the inhumanity of the atomic bombings, and the effects of the atomic bombings on the lives of the survivors.</p> <p>Furthermore, we aim to pass on the A-bomb experience as a memory of humanity to the next generation without letting it fade away.</p> <p>The author's role was to write the summary essay, serve as supervisor, interviewer, moderate questions with students, and otherwise produce.</p> <p>The interviewees for this interview were as follows.</p> <p>They were generally 14 years old and were exposed to the atomic bombing at an impressionable time.</p> <p>1) Mr.Toshio Kinoshita: "We survived the atomic bombing with a lot of help.</p> <p>2) Ms.Yoriko Asami: "Even in the midst of a hard life, I never lost hope.</p> <p>3) Mr.Chisei Kihara: "War is 'killing people.</p>
