Abstract	<p>The purpose of this research activity is to archive the life histories (oral histories) of A-bomb survivors by interviewing and researching them together with the younger generation (university students).</p> <p>Through this work, we will learn about the tragedy of war, the inhumanity of the atomic bombings, and the effects of the atomic bombings on the lives of the survivors.</p> <p>Furthermore, we aim to pass on the A-bomb experience as a memory of humanity to the next generation without letting it fade away.</p> <p>The author was in charge of supervising and editing the journal (e.g., serving as the main interviewer and MC for questions with students, correcting factual errors, and making annotations). Co-authors Susumu Iwamoto, President of Yudaen, and Kari Sakamoto, Executive Director of Yudaen, selected the speakers and served as coordinators. The speakers were as follows</p> <p>1) Mr.Sadao Ogasawara: "The Work of the Last Soldier," drafted at age 18 just before the atomic bombing, served at a clothing factory</p> <p>2) Mr.Takashi Matsukawa: "I want to convey my strong feelings, not memories of the facts," A-bombed at age 1</p> <p>3) Ms.Makio Oriide: "Accepting my fate, what to do next" A-bombed in the fourth grade of elementary school</p>
