Abstract	The purpose of this research activity is to archive the life histories (oral histories) of A-bomb survivors by interviewing and researching them together with the younger generation (university students). Through this work, we will learn about the tragedy of war, the inhumanity of the atomic bombings, and the effects of the atomic bombings on the lives of the survivors. Furthermore, we aim to pass on the A-bomb experience as a memory of humanity to the next generation without letting it fade away. In addition to the oral history, this volume also includes a Chinese translation of an essay by his son. Mr. Fumio Kumamoto, who compiled stories he heard from his father when he was a junior high school student. (1) Mr.Morio Kumamoto (A-bomb survivor: gazing at the burning stacks): A-bomb experience as recounted through the eyes of a later scholar of Japanese literature and bibliographer.
