表題	地域と学校の協働による子どものヘルスプロモーションと健康教育に関する考察～スイス・ヴォー州の事例を通して～
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Title	Consideration on child's health promotion and health education through collaboration between community and school ～Through the case of Vaud in Switzerland～
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Abstract	<p>Recently, in Switzerland, the movement to link education and health has become a priority initiative after the adaption of the Ottawa charter of 1986. It is characterized by orienting health education towards being more rooted in the community. Since then, the community health and school health sectors have jointly taken the responsibility to promote policies that address the health needs of children and adolescents, with health professionals working at schools through community based health centres. In particular, the canton of Vaud established "Health Promotion and Prevention at School (PSPS)" in 2011 as a structure of health promotion in school. In this paper, we describe its organizational principles and actual management.</p> <p>The canton of Vaud has taken action to promote cooperation by facilitating communication between health organizations. They are proud that Vaud is one of the most advanced cantons in terms of using an interdisciplinary approach that enables each specialist to widen the scope of his/her discipline. The cooperation method is achieved under the aegis of a so-called PSPS unit. In the PSPS unit, the doctor as the chief executive officer oversees the cooperative procedures between the education sector and the health sector.</p> <p>On the school site, the PSPS team embodies and implements the philosophy that the PSPS unit espouses. This team consists of professionals: school doctors, school nurses, the PSPS representative teachers, school mediators and others. They promote health education in cooperation with field teachers.</p> <p>The PSPS system presupposes the consistency of community health and school health. Each school accepts top-down policies from the PSPS unit, plans and implements projects that identify the actual condition of each school, and at the same time encourages bottom up implementation and coordination. In summary, Vaud's approach is also illustrative from the viewpoint of school education policy, in that there is a response to the demands of a modern society, such as collaboration and cooperation with the community.</p>
